The Department of Occupational Therapy is known nationally and internationally for its excellence: the department is ranked 3rd in the nation by *U.S. News and World Report* and was cited by ScholarGPS as #4 globally for lifetime research achievements in OT. The department offers graduate-level education to prepare students as leaders in the field of occupational therapy. Faculty are engaged in research and community outreach that meet the needs of people facing challenges in everyday life.

In 2022 the department transitioned from a Master's-level degree to a three-year professional Doctorate in Occupational Therapy. Using a carefully considered process, faculty developed a strong OTD program of study that has been approved at all University levels. The OTD Program earned a seven-year accreditation from the national accrediting body, ACOTE® (<https://acoteonline.org/>), in December 2024.
