CSU Online (<https://online.colostate.edu/>) is the distance-learning division of CSU in Fort Collins. It allows students globally to earn the same accredited degrees and certificates as on-campus students, taught by the exact same faculty. The only difference between CSU and CSU Online is the setting. When you enroll in one of CSU's online programs, you are enrolled at CSU, a top-tier, accredited institution. Online and on-campus students receive many of the same services. Online students also receive a diploma from CSU.

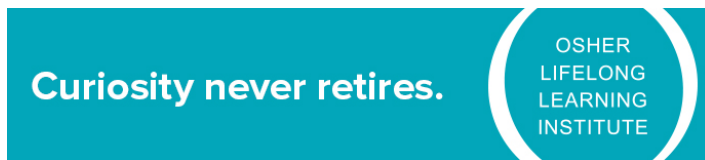
